Jessop Wing, Royal Hallamshire Hospital, Sheffield The Central Sheffield University Hospitals

- Four-storey 16,340 sq.m hospital extension
- Considerable value engineering cost savings
- Houses 120 beds and 53 cots in obstetrics, gynaecology and neonatology Services



Maternity Unit, Nottingham City Hospital Nottingham City Hospital NHS Trust

- A two/three-storey figure eight-shaped building
- Modelled around two central courtyards
- Full maternity care facilities
- Includes patient hotel and wards
- Heating/electrical services controlled by energy management system



Medical School, Derby City Hospital University of Nottingham/Southern Derbyshire Acute Hospitals NHS Trust Partnership

- Purpose-built four-storey Medical School
- Three-storey Clinical Sciences Building annex
- Logistical and traffic congestion problems overcome
- Extensive initial demolition work



Rehabilitation Unit, Edgware Hospital, London Barnet Healthcare NHS Trust

- New Brain Injury Rehabilitation Unit
- Refurbishment of three major multi-storey blocks
- Includes therapy areas, patient bedrooms, gymnasium, workshop, kitchen and staff facilities



**Daycase Surgical Unit, Sheffield
Northern General Hospital NHS Trust**

- Two-storey rapid response unit
- Air-conditioned operating theatres, anaesthetic and recovery rooms
- Reception area, consultancy suites, staff rooms and offices
- Access road and parking facilities
